



## The "Big Box"



**SEARCH & FUNCTIONS EASY TO FIND**  
The "big box" contains four tabs that guide you easily through the most common functions of the ACC: Search, Ask a Question, Add Content, and Other Actions. You will see only the functions for which you have access rights at each location. If you are not logged in to the system, you will see only the Search function. The "big box" appears on all community, special interest area, and topic pages. The task bar will appear at the top right of the page for contributions and profile pages.

## CoP & Topic Pages



### FILTERS

Filters have been added that allow you to filter by Helpful, Popular or New, and within New, you can further filter by time period. The default view is Show All.

### TABS

Each community and topic page is broken into six tabs (ie, views). The Main View is the primary view, containing the navigational graphic (if any), a list of all contributions specific to that page, etc. The All Contributions tab lists all contributions contained at that page and below (ie, the titles roll up, but the contributions remain where they were added). What's New supplies a rolled-up list of contributions added during the past 30 days at this location and below. Q&A contains a rolled-up list of all discussions posted at this location and below. Blogs now appear on the Blogs tab as well as on the poster's profile, but you see them only when you are logged in. The Members tab also appears only when you are logged in to ACC.



## RSS Feeds



Click the icon from any page to create an RSS feed for that page.



RSS stands for "Really Simple Syndication." ACC's RSS feeds are content feeds that contain links to new pages, contributions, and discussions on the ACC. You need special software called a feed reader or aggregator to use an RSS feed. Rather than visiting your communities each day to find out if there is new content, your feed reader shows it all to you in one page. ## View History



View History allows version control of community and topic pages, as well as of contributions. Previous versions may be viewed or compared to see what changes have been made.
