
PSM Implementing Directives



- Title 10 United States Code, Section 1732 and 1734.
- Public Law 111-84 (Reference (b)) directs a change to DoD policies designed to improve weapon systems life cycle management and product support by establishing new requirements that directly impact acquisition, fielding, and sustainment decisions.

Critical Acquisition Positions (CAP)



- All acquisition civilian and military positions in the grade of GS14 or broadband equiv and grade of LTC or above are designated as CAP.
- Level III Life Cycle Logistics must be qualified within 24 mos.
- All CAPs and KLPs must be coded with the correct Acquisition Position Code and updated in DCPDS and CAPPMS.
- Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act, Title 10, Section 1701-1764.
 - 3 year Tenure Agreement
- Elimination of Mobility Agreement (EXCEPTIONS) 8 May 2008
 - Acq SES positions, Civilians (KLPs)
 - CDG/AA Fellowship program for military,
- DD Form 2888, Critical Acquisition Position Service Agreement.





Key Leadership Position (KLP)



- KLPs are designated by the USD(ATL) and AAE and are a subset of CAP.
- Same requirements as CAP with addition of mobility agreement and grade level (LTC/GS14 (equiv) or above).
 - 3 Year Tenure Agreement
- All PSM assigned to a MDAPs and/or MAIS are assigned a KLP position. (effective 6 Oct 2010).
- Quarterly reviews by the DACM for ACAT I, II, and III programs.
- Mandatory training requirements as of June 15, 2011 for Deputy PMs.
- DD Form 2889, CAP Service Agreement Key Leadership position.
