SUBJECT: JDRS Tool Defense Business Systems Waiver

1. Program managers are granted a waiver from reporting Defense Business Systems (DBS) product deficiencies in JDRS for one year from the date of this letter.
2. DoDI 5000.02 (8 Dec 08) defines defense business systems. The term "defense business system" means an information system, other than a national security system, operated by, for, or on behalf of the Department of Defense, including financial systems, mixed systems, financial data feeder systems, IT and information assurance infrastructure. DBS supports business activities such as acquisition, financial management, logistics, strategic planning and budgeting, installations and environment, and human resource management.
3. This waiver is only for the use of the JDRS tool when an alternate tool is being used by the program office. All programs must continue to adhere to the requirements of TO 00-35D-54 deficiency reporting process, metric reporting and Self-Assessment Program (SAP)/Unit Compliance Inspection requirements.
4. The subject waiver is granted under the authority of AFI 63-101, Acquisition and Sustainment Logistics and the authority of the HQ AFMC/A4U Division Chief.
5. HQ AFMC has formed a team composed of representatives from organizations across the Air Force to study this issue and provide a final recommendation.
6. This waiver does not apply to any DBS that interfaces directly with safety of flight systems and whose failure could impact safety. Program managers shall advise HQ AFMC/A4UE of any such DBSs.
