MEMORANDUM FOR JT&E FEASIBILITY STUDY DIRECTORS FY 08

SUBJECT: JT&E Program Handbook Interim Change Notice 1-08

The *JT&E Program Handbook* shall guide the Feasibility Study Director (FSD) in the conduct of the Joint Feasibility Study (JFS), specifically, chapters 1, 2 and Annex L of Revision 1 dated June 29, 2007. That version plus this interim change, hereafter referred to as the "current" handbook, shall be used during the FY 08 JFS cycle to conduct studies, analyze options, and brief or provide briefing support to effectively and efficiently carryout the assigned tasks of the JFS.

Until the next handbook revision cycle, this memorandum shall be considered as part of the handbook and the FSD shall advise their staffs of the major changes presented below. These changes apply to the FY 08 JFSs only and do not apply to currently chartered Joint Tests. The following are subject changes to the current handbook:

- Project Master Plan (PMP) shall replace all instances of Program Test Plan (PTP) in the current handbook. The JFS shall produce a PMP with the assistance of the Joint Test Support Cell (JTSC).
- The PMP outline replaces the PTP outline contained in Appendix L-2 located on pages L-2-1 to L-2-104 of the current handbook.

The PMP outline shall be provided separately by the JTSC team leader. The JTSC team shall assist the FSD in developing the PMP using the provided outline. All questions or potential conflicts with other sections of the current handbook shall be brought to the attention of the JTSC team lead upon discovery. Any discrepancy or suggested correction shall be brought to the attention of the JT&E Technical Directors through the JTSC team lead.
