What Is COSIS?

The NAVSUP WSS COSIS program and management system ensures materials are protected, stored and maintained in ready-for-issue condition and prevents deterioration of unserviceable materials.



COSIS includes correcting packaging deficiencies, replacing damaged packaging materials, relocating items to more suitable storage locations, and coordinating with inventory managers to dispose of unnecessary or outdated material to reduce storage costs and free up storage space. COSIS helps optimize ashore and afloat Operational Readiness.

COSIS Program Highlights

- A storage site inspects the packaging of Navy material in its custody
- If deterioration or incorrect packaging is revealed, the storage site submits a request for approval to correct the deficiency to the NAVSUP WSS COSIS Program Manager
- Inventory Managers validate whether material with deteriorated packaging is still required
- NAVSUP WSS reviews requests, approves funding or initiates disposition
