THE FISCAL YEAR 2013 AND 2014 WORLDWIDE AMMUNITION LOGISTICS AND EXPLOSIVE SAFETY REVIEW PROGRAMS CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH (IAW) ARMY REGULATION 700-13 REVEALED A HIGH LEVEL OF NON-COMPLIANCE IN THE AREA OF LIGHT BOX MANAGEMENT. TO ENHANCE COMPLIANCE AND BEST PRACTICES FOR THE PACKING, MARKING, AND SEALING OF AMMUNITION AND EXPLOSIVES (A&E) CONTAINERS THE INFORMATION IS PROVIDED.

6. MIL-STD 129P, PARAGRAPH 5.14.4.2.F(4) STATES: IN A GENERAL SHIPPING SITUATION, ONE LIGHT BOX PER LOT, PER CONDITION CODE, PER STRUCTURE. MARKING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIGHT BOXES IS LOCATED IN MIL-STD 129P, PARAGRAPH 5.14.4.2.F(2).

7. INCOMPLETE BOXES OF AMMUNITION AND EXPLOSIVES MAY BE STORED IN MAGAZINES CONTAINING ITEMS WHICH ARE PACKED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPROVED DRAWINGS; THE BOXES MUST BE MARKED CONSPICUOUSLY TO IDENTIFY THE CONTENTS AND QUANTITIES AND PLACED IN DESIGNATED LOCATIONS IAW DA PAM 385-64, PARAGRAPH 3-2.H.
