SUBJECT: 2015 Product Support Manager Workshop

It is my pleasure to announce the 2015 Office of the Secretary of Defense Product Support Manager (PSM) Workshop. The workshop theme is Tangible Tools for the Workforce and will feature government and industry presentations on Cost and Affordability (Day 1), Support and Sustainment (Day 2), and Industry Perspectives and Incentives (Day 3). This workshop will provide an opportunity to develop the workforce's Life Cycle Logistics competency in applying Better Buying Power (BBP) 2.0 principles, share best practices, and strengthen collaboration between industry and government leaders. The 2015 PSM Workshop will begin on Tuesday, January 13, 2015, with check in starting at 7:30am, and will conclude at 12:00pm, on Thursday, January 15, 2015. The workshop will take place at the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) in Howell Auditorium, Scott Hall, Building 226 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia. For those outside the local area who cannot attend the workshop, Video Teleconference Capability (VTC) will be available at all DAU locations and up to 12 additional dial-in sites.
