USMC DMSMS Work Group Charter

A. Purpose and Scope:

- a. This charter identifies and establishes the USMC Diminishing Manufacturing Sources and Material Shortages (DMSMS) Working Group. The United States Marine Corps desires proactive DMSMS program be institutionalized throughout the Corps and this responsible body is chartered to developed policies and procedures that will provide a proactive, disciplined approach to define, measure, analyze, improve and control DMSMS issues in order to improve Marine Corps systems availability, reduce total life cycle costs and increase readiness.


B. Functions: Meet at a minimum, quarterly, or as required, to plan and execute its responsibilities and perform the following functions:

- a. Develop USMC policy to implement the DoN Strategic Plan for DMSMS.
- b. Remain focused on achieving the goals outlined in the DoN Strategic Plan for DMSMS.
- c. Develop presentations with the primary focus to promote initiatives and capabilities to the USMC DMSMS Community.
- d. Plan and execute DMSMS Workshops.
- e. Support the USMC DMSMS community by providing and promoting training, teaming opportunities, general information, and initiatives related to DMSMS.
- f. Develop the criteria and administer the process for awarding the Achievement Awards that are presented at the annual DMSMS Conference.
- g. Promote active utilization of the Marine Corps module of the Shared Data Warehouse (SDW), DMSMS Knowledge Sharing Portal (DKSP), and the Government Industry Data Exchange Program (GIDEP).

C. Organization and Management

- a. The Working Group will be chaired by the MARCORSSYSCOM AC-LCL and co-chaired by HQMC I&L. The chair will:
 - i. Assemble a team of representatives from appropriate activities to effectively perform the functions delineated.
 - ii. Establish the time and location of meetings as required.
 - iii. Coordinate resource requirements with the WG.
- b. Membership: The USMC DMSMS WG will be comprised of active working members representing each of the core members listed in the attachment.
 - i. Additional members may be appointed as appropriate to accommodate the WG mission.
 - ii. The WG affairs will be managed by consensus of the membership.
 - iii. Any proposed changes to this charter require unanimous support of the team members and concurrence of the WG.

- D. This working group is chartered by Marine Corps Systems Command, Assistant Commander, Life Cycle Logistics, Ms. Kelly Gibson.
