DEGRADATION IN MUZZLE VELOCITY FOR OLDER C995, LAUNCHER AND CARTRIDGE, 84MM, M136 (AT4), NSN 1315-01-245-4950 AND 1315-01-486-2293

Request a copy of this AIN be provided to all Users, Quality Assurance Specialist Ammunition Surveillance (QASAS)/Ammunition Inspectors, Range Safety Officers (RSO) and Ammunition Supply Point (ASP) Personnel. This AIN shall be provided to all Units at time of issue of this ammunition.

The purpose of this [AIN](#) is to inform users of issues encountered while firing older stocks of C995, Launcher and Cartridge, 84MM, M136 (AT4), NSN 1315-01-245-4950 and 1315-01-486-2293.

AIN 063-16,
IN SUPPORT OF AN URGENT MATERIAL RELEASE (UMR) FOR THE STRYKER REACTIVE ARMOR TILES II (SRAT II) FOR USE ON THE STRYKER FAMILY OF VEHICLES (FOV).

DODICS: MP31, MP32, MP33, MP34, MP35, MP36, MP37 AND MP38

A copy of this [AIN](#) is to be provided to all Units using subject items.

The SRAT II does contain explosives materials. The SRAT II contains LBR6 Explosive which is an insensitive, low flammability, and high explosive. The Final Hazard Classifications (FHC) information for the SRAT II is provided in Table 1 and Table 2 in attachment AIN 063-16A.

This AIN summarizes the identified hazards and associated actions to mitigate those hazards.

Under wartime conditions, satisfies the commanders' conventional ammunition tactical information requirements

Provides informational processing support for conventional ammunition logistical support applications at installations, storage points, divisions, corps, and Echelons Above Corps (EAC)

System has the ability to operate under interrupted and low bandwidth environments. System does not have the ability to operate in a disconnected environment.
