MUZZLE VELOCITY VARIATION (MVV) FOR SPECIFIC LOTS OF CARTRIDGE, 105MM, M1 (DODAC 1315-C445) THAT CONTAIN INCORRECTLY LOADED CHARGE, PROPELLING, 105MM, M67

Request that this information be disseminated to all organizations/activities that store and maintain conventional ammunition, all 105MM Artillery Units, Range Safety Officers, Quality Assurance Specialist (Ammunition Surveillance) (QASAS) and Ammunition Supply Point (ASP) Personnel. QASAS will ensure that Unit Ammunition Officers are briefed on this [AIN](#) prior to issuing specific lots identified in this AIN. The information contained in this AIN will also appear in an Operator's Note to AFATDS.

HQ, Joint Munitions Command Materiel Master Request Form – MMR User Guide Version 2.1

Materiel Master Request form is a SharePoint form that is stored in the AMC Enterprise Portal (AEP) under Headquarters Joint Munitions Command SharePoint site. The form is generated when a new or change to a NIIN or MANP is needed for a specific requirement into LMP. The form incorporates a SharePoint workflow that is used to send email notifications and update fields. It is managed by the JMC, Material Master Cell (MMC) and is supported by Information Management (AMSJM-IMK) at HQ, Joint Munitions Command.

This [MMR User Guide](#) has step-by-step instructions on how to access the MMR SharePoint Application; submit a new MMR Form; how to track submitted forms; status of forms; how to cancel a MMR; and Points of Contact.

Class 5 Non-Standard Material SOP/Process and Procedures

[This Guide](#) has step-by-step procedures for changes in Non-Standard Ammunition (NSA) material. All requests for creation of or changes to NSA materials from non-LMP users will go through the AESIP Portal. If the requestor/user is submitting a request to create a new NSA material in the AESIP master catalog, they will first use the search tools on the AESIP Portal to determine if the material already exists in the catalog. If the material is not found already cataloged in AESIP, the requestor will fill out a form requesting a new NSA material creation.
