Brief abstracts for both the “General Session” and the “Restricted Session” are now being accepted. Abstracts should be no longer than one page and indicate whether it’s for the General Session or the Restricted Session. Abstracts should be submitted to [disa.usna.os.mbx.e3coordinator@mail.mil](mailto:disa.usna.os.mbx.e3coordinator@mail.mil). Twenty-minute timeslots will be allocated for presentations. The General Session will accommodate unclassified presentations that are approved for public release. The Restricted Session will accommodate presentations that are distribution limited or classified up to "SECRET."

The Program Review is an information exchange forum for DoD Components, the Federal Government, and Industry E3 and Spectrum Management professionals to collaborate, network, and meet to discuss policy and regulations, acquisition trends, operational supportability, and emerging technology. It also features dozens of technical presentations, several training seminars, and many working groups, ad hoc meetings, and exhibitions.
