Timothy A. Beyland, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Air Force Program Executive Officer for Combat and Mission Support, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition, Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington, D.C. The Program Executive Officer for Combat and Mission Support is responsible for acquiring services valued at more than \$100 million. He oversees acquisition planning and ensures that proper management controls are in place after the contract is awarded. The Deputy Secretary of Defense appointed Mr. Beyland to serve as chief of the U.S. delegation to the NATO Airborne Early Warning and Control Programme Management Organization, and he is chairman of that organization's Board of Directors.

Mr. Beyland was born in Castro Valley, Calif. He graduated from Centerville High School in 1976, and attended Miami University where he completed undergraduate and graduate work. He entered federal service in October 1981 as a member of the Air Force Logistics Command Mid-Level Management Training Program at Kelly Air Force Base, Texas.

Mr. Beyland serves on the Air Force Corrections Board for Military Records, Air Force Incentive Awards Board, Air Force Contract Adjustment Board and Contract Airlift Rate Adjustment Board.
