Mr. Dan Bowman is the Chief of the Air Force Procurement Transformation Office in the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Contracting, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition, Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Washington D.C. He is responsible for all aspects of the Air Force's Procurement Transformation efforts as it relates to the policy, process, people, and technology involved in the acquisition of weapon systems, logistics support, materiel and services for the Air Force.

Mr. Bowman began his career as a "Mid-Management Intern" trainee in October 1983 in the Directorate of Contracting at the San Antonio Air Logistics Center, Kelly AFB, TX. He was selected to the "Copper Cap" management intern program in April 1985 and became a Contracting Officer and worked in various buying sections in the directorate. In 1994 as Branch Chief, Aircraft and Engine Accessories Mr. Bowman directed a maintenance organization of 220 employees through five section chiefs for production (repair, overhaul and testing), engineering, planning, scheduling, and inventory control of over 400 part numbers for various aircraft and engine accessories. Mr. Bowman was selected in 1996 by the SA-ALC Center Commander to direct the activities of a 32-member, multidiscipline integrated product team in the execution of the first ever public/private competition of an Air Force depot for the C-5 Business Area Competition, valued at approximately \$860M. From this position he was selected by the Senior Acquisition Executive of the Air Force to direct the public/private competition for the Sacramento Depot Workload, valued at approximately \$1.5B.
