Mr. John L. Robuck is the Assistant for FAR in the Policy and Implementation Division, SAF/AQCP, Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Air Force (Contracting). SAF/AQCP is responsible for developing and implementing policy and procedures used in contracting throughout the Air Force, and for publishing the Air Force Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement used by Air Force major commands and contracting activities. Mr. Robuck is currently the Air Force Policy Member of the Defense Acquisition Regulations Council.

Mr. Robuck began his contracting career in 1971 as a Contract Specialist at Warner Robins Air Logistics Center at Robins Air Force Base in Georgia. For the next ten years at Robins he was a contract negotiator and contracting officer, buying major equipment and services associated with avionics, airborne radar and electronic warfare systems. He was selected for the Air Force's "COPPER CAP" Contracting Executive Training Program in 1977.

In 1981 he was assigned as a Procurement Analyst on the Air Staff at the Pentagon, in what is now SAF/AQC, where he was responsible for contracting policy in the areas of competition, spare parts, and small purchases. In 1984 he assumed responsibility for the specialized areas of International Acquisition and Foreign Military Sales contract policy. In 1988 he was selected to be the Deputy Chief of the Operational Contracting Division, which was responsible for the general and operational contracting policies used by the Air Force.

Mr. Robuck served as Deputy Chief of SAF/AQCP from March, 1996 until February, 2002. He also served as the Air Force Policy Member of the DAR Council from September, 1997 through February, 2000, a position he assumed again in February of 2002 on a full-time basis. He is the Chair of the DAR Council's Standard Procurement System ("SPS") Committee, and is a Panel Chair on the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records.

Mr. Robuck has a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism from the University of Georgia, and a Master of Science in Administration (Management) from Georgia College. He is a graduate of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, and has completed the Executive Management Program at Pennsylvania State University. He has a Level III Certification as an Acquisition Professional in Contracting.
